
the Crime Prevention Research Center (CPRC) has found that **97.8** % of mass public shootings between 1950 and 2018 have occurred in "gun free zones."

"Gun free zones are, as so much evidence proves, essentially 'sitting duck' zones, where only criminals are armed. So-called 'gun free zones' illustrate, better than any other antigun mandate, how, like any law, gun control only controls law-abiding citizens, and does nothing to thwart criminals.




